



Nurse Practitioner Student & Doctoral Studies Awards

Submissions deadline is October 29th at noon. The student must hold an up-to-date membership with NPAM. Award winners will be announced at the 2021 Nurse Practitioner Association Annual General Meeting, being held virtually on November 18th, 2021 @ 6:30pm.

NPAM will award 3 scholarships valued at \$250 each. Ideally the breakdown would be a 1st yr, 2nd year, and Doctoral studies, however, allocation may change dependent upon applications received.

The scholarships will be awarded to active student NPAM members enrolled in NP studies at a recognized post-secondary institution.

Students are invited to submit an application (see p.2) for the award detailing:

- The reason they chose to pursue the Nurse Practitioner stream of nursing.
- Past and present community involvement.

Preference will be given to a student who:

- Demonstrates excellence in scholarship (GPA 3.5 or greater).

Applications should be no longer than 500 words and must be accompanied by a CV.

Doctoral studies

A doctoral studies scholarship will be awarded to an active NPAM member pursuing doctoral studies at a recognized post-secondary institution. Preference will be given to those who have been actively involved with NPAM. The successful applicant for this award will only be granted funds once during the course of his/her studies.
